

MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL INTERVIEWING COMMITTEE MEETING OF THE CITY OF PAWNEE CITY, HELD ON WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 8, 2021, AT 7:00 P.M. AT THE LIBRARY MEETING ROOM, 735 8TH STREET, ALL IN PAWNEE CITY, PAWNEE COUNTY, NEBRASKA.

Notice of this special Interviewing Committee meeting was given in advance thereof by posting in four prominent places, a designated method for giving notice as shown by the Affidavit of Posting on file in the office of the City Clerk. Notice of this special interviewing committee meeting was given to the Interviewing Committee and a copy of their acknowledgment of receipt of the notice and the Agenda are on file in the office of the City Clerk. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the advance notice and in the notice to the Interviewing Committee of this meeting. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

Executive Session for City Foreman Position: Council Member Eisenhower moved to go into Closed Session for the purpose of performing job interviews for the open City Crew position to prevent needless injury to the reputation of a person and if such person has not requested a public meeting at 7:02 p.m. Council Member Fisher seconded the motion. Roll Call vote indicated all present voting in favor of the motion, whereupon motion carried. Foreman Cumley and Clerk Curtis remained in closed session throughout the whole interview process. Council Member Eisenhower moved to come out of Closed Session at 8:24 p.m. Council Member Fisher seconded the motion. The Interviewing Committee will make it's recommendation to the Mayor and Council on who to hire to fill the open City Crew position at the September 13th regular City Council meeting. Roll Call vote indicated all present voting in favor of the motion, whereupon motion carried, and the meeting adjourned at 8:25 p.m.
